| Permission to cut up: an old T-shirt an old pair of jeans | Plus: a red piece of cloth black paper | elastic scissors | belt glue |

Here's what to do!



CLOTHES: Cut off the jeans just below the knee in a ragged edge. Cut off the arms of the shirt in a ragged edge, too, and perhaps cut a little off the bottom edge.



BELT & SCARF: Fold the piece of red cloth into a triangle, wrap it around your head and tie in a knot. Put the belt around your waist.

EYEPATCH:

Cut a half-circle out of black paper. Cut a long piece of elastic, and lay it along the straight edge of the circle. Fold over the straight edge of the circle, and glue it down to itself, over the elastic. Tie the elastic ends together so it fits your head. 4
